



Ride for a reason 2020 | Custom Ride for a reason Challenge Tour Jersey | TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Instructions to enter the Ride for a reason 2020 (RFAR20) Registration Draw (the Draw) form part of these conditions.
2. To be eligible to receive a prize, supporters (Entrants) must be a registered Tour Down Under Challenge Tour participant and registered Ride for a reason Challenge Tour rider. Entrants must have raised a minimum of \$500 in donations before 11:59pm on 31 December 2019. Entry is automatic, based on receipt of total donations received by the above date.

4. Employees of the Promoter and its members are ineligible to enter the Draw.

The custom jersey will be issued directly by South Australian Tourism Commission via the Tour Village and in place of the standard Challenge Tour Jersey issued to the general public. Lost jerseys cannot be replaced.

The Promoter and its members accept no responsibility for the collection or distribution of Challenge Tour jerseys, nor changes to collections times as promoted by The Sponsor.

Custom Jerseys cannot be purchased and/or exchanged for other components of the Ride for a reason kit.

The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any technological malfunction or failure, Internet traffic congestion, or for outdated or incorrect contact details by which the entrant cannot be contacted during business hours on relevant dates.
